«« MPOX »»

Mpox (previously monkeypox) is a viral infection which can spread between people, mainly through close contact. It can cause a painful rash, enlarged lymph nodes and fever.



MPOX SPREADS

- * person-to-person, through touch, kissing, or sex, or by talking or breathing close to someone who has mpox,
- * from infected animals, when hunting, skinning, or cooking them,
- * from contaminated materials, such as sheets, towels, clothes or needles,
- * during pregnancy, when the virus may be passed on to the unborn baby.



SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

Symptoms of mpox are

- * Rash which may last for 2–4 weeks
- * Fever, headache, muscle aches, back pain, low energy and swollen glands (lymph nodes)
- * The rash can affect the face, palms of the hands, soles of the feet, groin, genitals or anus.
- * Some patients may get very sick and require hospitalization.
